THE DELAWARE COUNTY CONSERVATION CAMPGROUNDS ARE OPEN.

Delaware County Conservation is announcing further changes to its operations. Campgrounds at Baileys Ford, Turtle Creek, Twin Bridges, Coffins Grove and Fountain Springs:

- Electric service is on
- Water service is expected to be on by Friday, May 22, 2020
- Shower house remains closed at Baileys Ford
- Dump station is open
- No firewood sales
- Playgrounds remain closed
- Latrines are open – use at your own risk – it is suggested bringing your own sanitizer
- 14 day stay limit
- Fountain Springs remains primitive camping only

At this time, for the safety of our staff we will not be collecting camping fees. We are in the process of changing over to a self-registration system. However, if you wish, you can mail in a donation to help cover the cost of camping and utilities to:
